Dear Citizens,

Some of you longtime residents may remember me as your paperboy. I am a graduate of Ascension, St. Xavier, and the University of Louisville. I have been a homeowner here since 2005 and a member of the city council since 2012. My wife Kelly and I have been blessed with the opportunity to raise our two children in this neighborhood. In the coming months you will notice new post top fixtures being installed on all the city's streetlight posts. The council voted unanimously to upgrade to new LED post tops fixtures. This decision was made to keep uniformity in the fixture appearance due to LG&E discontinuing the use of our current bulbs. This will also lower the city's operation costs with lower energy consumption and decrease outages with longer life fixtures.

We have recently received some concerns from residents regarding on street parking. Neighbors across from one another are choosing to park cars on both sides of the street which seriously restricts

traffic flow. Not only is it a hinderance to the general traffic pattern but more importantly, it greatly reduces response time of emergency service vehicles getting to their destination. I would respectfully request everyone please have the courtesy to take steps to avoid clogging the traffic artery by parking in the driveway, where possible, or the same side of the street. Ask yourself, if it was your loved one needing emergency services would you want that time to be delayed by such a preventable obstacle?

Finally, I would like to thank council member, Cheryl Willet, for her work putting on the Christmas party again this year. Her efforts always result in a great event. After being restricted to drive thru events the past few years, it was nice to meet in person.

Following are the Minutes of the December 6, 2022 City Council Meeting for the City of St. Regis Park, held at 7:00 p.m. at the Jeffersontown Fire Station #2.

Ms. Willett made a motion to approve the November 2022 financials. The motion was seconded by Mr. Shackelford, and it passed without dissent.

Ms. Willett made a motion to approve Mr. Schweickhardt as a financial signatory for all city financial transactions at River City Bank, PNC, and Fifth Third Securities, effective 1/3/2023. Mr. Shackelford seconded the motion, and it passed without dissent. Mr. Davis will be removed as a registered signatory for the city and the bonding company will be notified of the changes.

Mr. Amback made a motion to approve the November 2022 meeting minutes. The motion was seconded by Mr. Sanderfer, and it passed without dissent.

Mr. Schweickhardt made a motion to approve the conversion of the city street lights to LED bulbs. Ms. Willett seconded the motion, and it passed without dissent.

Mr. Weis made a motion to change the monthly council meeting to the 3rd Wednesday of every month, starting in February 2023. Mr. Amback seconded the motion, and it passed, with Ms. Willett and Mr. Sanderfer opposing. This motion is contingent upon the approval of the Jeffersontown Fire Department approving the use of the meeting space.

Mr. Shackelford made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Mr. Sanderfer, and it passed without dissent. The meeting adjourned at 8:11pm
