Dear Citizens,

Greetings everyone! I hope you are all as eager to enjoy the upcoming spring weather as I am. Fortunately, mother nature has given us a preview in recent days. I have always enjoyed St Regis in the springtime due to the work so many of you have done to upgrade your landscapes over the years. This is one of the reasons our property values stay higher than some comparable cities in Louisville. Keep up the great work.

Several topics were discussed at the February council meeting. First and foremost, our sanitation contractor Rumpke will not be extending current collection rates once our two-year contract expires this summer. They have told us rates will go up from \$19 to \$28 per month per household. Due to the increase, by ordinance we must put this work out for public bid. The bid advertisement will request pricing to mirror our current services, which consists of rear door pickup of household trash and curbside pickup of recycling and yard waste. We will also consider pricing without rear door pickup as a cost saving measure for all residents. We are aware this may be an issue for some of our disabled residents so please reach out to me or one of the council members if this will affect you. The current rear door service only includes the household trash. Recycling and yard waste must be taken to the curb. Please keep this in mind as I ask you if rear door service is worth the additional cost?

The council and I had a productive discussion about the potential operation of Airbnb's in our city, which are allowed in the city of Louisville. As a fourth-class city, St Regis Park has the authority to pass an ordinance to either prohibit Airbnb's to operate or operate on a limited basis. That limited basis may include just Derby week or PGA Championships to name some examples. Personally, I am opposed to allowing Airbnb's to operate any more than a limited basis. While I realize most Airbnb occupants will

not cause a problem, I think we invite potential for undesirable outcomes with individuals with no stake in keeping a peaceful environment in our city.

Finally, I wanted to invite you all to the 2023 St Regis Park Easter Egg Hunt. This year's event will be Saturday April 8th at 10:00 AM on the Ascension Football Field. Bring the kids and grandkids out to collect eggs and get your picture taken with the Easter Bunny. This event has always been a great time.


