**CITY OF ST. REGIS PARK
ORDINANCE NO. 7, SERIES 2023-2024
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE SECTION 50.01 RELATING TO
GARBAGE COLLECTION**

WHEREAS, The City of St. Regis Park Council finds that residents placing their garbage carts into travelled portion of the street on collection day is a safety hazard and the city's ordinances should be updated to make it clear that garbage must not be placed in the road,

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City of St. Regis Park,

SECTION 1:

The City of St. Regis Park does hereby amend ordinance Section 50.01 as follows:

§ 50.01 PLACEMENT; COLLECTION AND REMOVAL.

(A) No garbage, grass or trash shall be placed at the curb side before 3:00 p.m., the day prior to pickup.

(B) All garbage cans and items not collected shall be removed from the curb side by 7:00 a.m., the day after pickup.

(C) During the fall of the year, leaves may be placed at the curb side the day prior to pickup after 3:00 p.m., as provided in division (A).

(D) The placement of garbage, grass, leaves or trash at the curb side shall not extend past the edge of pavement and shall be within the area extending at least five feet from the curb toward the nearest front yard. property line.

SECTION 2:

This ordinance shall take effect upon enactment and publication according to law.

Did You Know?

71.04 QUALIFICATIONS FOR OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS AND ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES ON CITY STREETS

(A) A golf cart or ATV operating on a city street shall be insured in compliance with KRS 304.39-080 by the owner or operator, and the proof of insurance shall be inside the vehicle at all times of operation on a city street.

(B) Any person operating a low-speed vehicle on a city street shall be subject to the traffic regulations of KRS Chapter 189.

(C) A golf cart or ATV operated on a city street shall:

(1) Prior to seeking a city permit, be inspected by a certified inspector designated by the County Sheriff, and certified through the Department of Vehicle Regulation to ensure that the vehicle complies with the requirements of KRS 189.286. The inspection fee under this section shall not exceed \$5 with an additional fee not to exceed \$10 per trip charged if it becomes necessary for the certified inspector to travel to the site of the golf cart rather than having the golf cart brought to the Sheriff's inspection area.

(2) Be issued a sticker or permit for the golf cart or ATV by the city. The fee for an initial permit or sticker for low-speed vehicle from the city shall be \$25. A permit shall be valid until the first day of March of the following year. The fee for a renewal permit or sticker from the city shall be \$15; and

(3) Display the permit or sticker issued by the city on the front of the vehicle that identifies that the golf cart or ATV is allowed to be operated on city streets.
