92.03 PROPERTY MAINTENANCE STANDARDS

GRASS AND WALKWAY OBSTRUCTION

It is hereby declared to be a public nuisance for any property owner (or other person in control of the property) to keep or maintain property, premises, or rights-of-way adjacent to the premises, in such a manner which causes, or tends to cause, substantial diminution in value of other properties, or which renders such properties as dangerous, or detrimental, or adverse to the health, or welfare, or offensive to the senses of the residents of the city. This includes, but is not limited to, the following conditions, which are hereby declared a nuisance.

- (A) Grass. All grass within the city limits shall be limited to nine inches in height. All curbs shall be maintained to prohibit any grass from growing over the curb.*
- (B) Walkway obstruction. All owners of property abutting a sidewalk shall maintain an unobstructed walkway of at least eight feet in height. Branches or trees and shrubs shall not encroach upon any sidewalk, sidewalk height restriction, nor the 13 feet, six-inch vertical clearance required above any roadway.*
- (H) Permits the accumulation of ashes, leaves, wood, lumber, limbs, twigs, storm debris and/or any residue from the burning of any combustible material.*
- (I) Any tree, stack, or other object standing in such a condition that is likely cause hurt, damage or injury to persons or property by falling thereof or of parts thereof.*

U.S. flag etiquette

Proper display and care of the American flag honors the nation and the men and women who sacrificed to preserve it.

How to display the flag outdoors

- The flag should be displayed with the field of stars at the top of the flag staff or pole.
- Never display another flag (state, organization or corporate) above or to the right of the American flag.
- When displayed with the flags of other nations, never display the U.S. flag at a lower height than the other flags.
- When displaying the flag above a street, the field of stars should be at the top of the flag and face north or east.

Do not do this to a flag

- The flag should never be used as an advertisement or as clothing, bedding or draperies.
- Never hang the flag upside down, except as a distress signal.
- Don't display tattered, faded or worn flags. They should be destroyed with dignity.

How to display the flag indoors

- The flag should be displayed in a place of honor, to the right side of the stage. Other flags should be on the left side of the stage.
- When displayed flat against a wall, the field of stars should be in the upper left corner of the flag, whether the flag is displayed vertically or horizontally.
- The American flag should be displayed in the center and at the highest point when grouped with state or organization flags.

Caring for the flag

- Take the flag in at dusk or during inclement weather.
- The flag should never be thrown into the trash, but burned in a proper ceremony. Contact the American Legion or Boy Scouts.
- Clean and mend the flag, as needed.
