They must function much like a vehicle with features such as seat belts, turning signals, brake lights, headlights etc. Normal traffic laws apply which means only licensed drivers can operate so children cannot drive golf carts on the streets. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

CITY OF ST. REGIS PARK ORDINANCE NO. 4, 2023-2024 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 50.16 RELATING TO DUMPSTERS

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the dumpster ordinance prohibition on placing dumpsters on the street should be changed for instances when placement on the street is the only option, such as when driveways are being replaced,

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City of St. Regis Park,

SECTION 1:

The City of St. Regis Park does hereby amend ordinance Section 50.16 (C) as follows:

50.16 DUMPSTERS

(C) Dumpsters must be located only on the driveway, as far back on the driveway, as possible and at no time may it be placed on the street, except where placement on the street is the only practical option, the placement is approved by the city, the dumpster has reflectors to alert traffic at night and the owner agrees to be responsible for the repair of any damage to the public street. Such unit shall be located no closer than ten feet to any property line.

SECTION 2:

This ordinance shall take effect upon enactment and publication according to law.

Did You Know?

ANIMALS RUNNING AT LARGE

90.01 DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of this chapter, the following definitions shall apply unless the context clearly indicates or requires a different meaning.

ABANDON. Abandonment shall constitute the relinquishment of all rights and claims by the owner to the animal. (KRS 257.100(4))

AT LARGE. Off the premises of the owner, and not under the control of the owner or his agent either by leash, cord, chain or otherwise.

OWNER. Every person having a right of property to an animal and every person who keeps or harbors an animal, has it in his care, or permits it to remain on or about the premises owned or occupied by him.

90.02 ANIMALS RUNNING AT LARGE

- (A) No person who is the owner of any animal shall permit it to run at large in any public road, highway, street, lane, or alley, or upon or enclosure without the consent of the owner of the yard, lot, or enclosure.
- (B) The owner of an animal who permits it to run at large in violation of this section is liable for all damages caused by the animal upon the premises of another.


